SETS OF DOCUMENTS RELATING TO U.S. LOSSES IN SOUTHEAST ASIA. ONE SET OF DOCUMENTS CONTAINED A REPORT TITLED: "REPORT ON RESULTS OF OPERATIONS OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR'S (MOI) SPECIAL INFORMATION SEEKING GROUP." THIS REPORT INCLUDED TEN DOCUMENTS. THE SECOND SET OF DOCUMENTS WAS A REPORT FROM THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE (MOD) MIA SPECIALIST TEAM TITLED: "REPORT OF RESULTS OF UNILATERAL OPERATIONS TO COLLECT MIA INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS." THIS REPORT INCLUDED THREE DOCUMENTS. THE THIRD SET OF DOCUMENTS WAS A VIETNAM OFFICE OF SEEKING PERSON (VNOSMP) ASSESSMENT OF THE 84 SPECIAL REMAINS TEAM (SRT) CASES.

2. THE MOI REPORT, "REPORT ON RESULTS OF OPERATIONS OF THE MOI'S SPECIAL INFORMATION SEEKING GROUP" DETAILS A 4-12 MAY 95 EFFORT BY THE MOI TO SEARCH FOR POW/MIA INFORMATION IN VINH PHU, TUYEN QUANG, YEN BAI, HOA BINH, NINH BINH AND THANH HOA PROVINCES. THE REPORT BRIEFLY DESCRIBES DOCUMENTS AND SKETCH MAPS RECOVERED AND/OR PHOTOGRAPHED IN THE VARIOUS PROVINCES BY THE SPECIAL INFORMATION SEEKING GROUP. ONE OF THE DOCUMENTS WAS TITLED, "SITUATION OF AMERICAN BANDIT PILOT GRAVES IN THANH HOA TERRITORY."

3. THE DOCUMENT PROVIDES LIMITED CASUALTY-RELATED INFORMATION. JTF-FA ANALYSTS HAVE IDENTIFIED LINE ENTRIES POSSIBLY CORRELATING WITH UNRESOLVED CASES *DATA* *DATA* 0350, AND *DATA* AND RESOLVED CASES: 0093, 0667, 0457, 0255, 1789, 0375-0-01, 0575-1-01, 0083-0-01 AND 1915-1-01.

4. THE DOCUMENT IS A LIST OF 19 LINE ITEMS IN TABULAR FORM, WITH THREE DATA COLUMNS ON EACH LINE. THE TRANSLATION BELOW LISTS HEADING INFORMATION FOR THE DOCUMENT FOLLOWED BY EACH LINE ENTRY. THE THREE DATA COLUMNS ARE SET APART BY SEMICOLONS (;). DIRECT TRANSLATIONS FROM THE DOCUMENT ARE ENCLOSED IN QUOTATIONS. EACH LINE ENTRY IS FOLLOWED BY JTF-FA ANALYTICAL COMMENTS ENCLOSED IN DOUBLE PARENTHESES (()).

- ((REGARDING)) THE SITUATION ON GRAVES OF PILOTS BURIED IN THE LOCAL AREA ((THAT WE)) WANT TO FIND, THERE WERE NO COFFINS, ONLY DIRT SPREAD CURSORILY OVER ((THE BODIES)) AND NO MARKINGS, THEREFORE NOW THERE ARE ONLY 19 GUYS WHO STILL HAVE GRAVES. ((WE)) DID NOT FIND GRAVES FOR THE REMAINING 17 GUYS.
- ACCORDING TO LOCAL RECORDS THERE ARE GRAVES FOR AMERICAN BANDIT PILOTS AS FOLLOWS:"

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "1); QUANG VINH (QUANG XUONG); 4 GUYS; GRAVES OF 2 GUYS STILL EXTANT." ((THIS LINE ENTRY POSSIBLY CORRELATES WITH RESOLVED CASE 0093, BASED ON PROVINCE, DISTRICT AND VILLAGE OF LOSS. CASE 0093 WAS THE ONLY CASE IN QUANG VINH VILLAGE TO INVOLVE THE LOSS OF FOUR U. S. SERVICE MEMBERS. THE BURIAL SITE COORDINATES ASSOCIATED WITH CASE 0093 ARE LOCATED IN QUANG VINH VILLAGE. IN ADDITION, ENTRY 8 OF REF B NAMES THE FOUR PERSONS BURIED IN QUANG VINH VILLAGE. THE FOUR NAMES CORRELATE WITH THE FOUR PERSONS LOST IN THE REFNO 0093 INCIDENT.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "2); QUANG YEN (QUANG XUONG); 1 GUY; GRAVE NO LONGER EXTANT." ((THIS LINE ENTRY POSSIBLY CORRELATES WITH CASE DATA AN UNRESOLVED CASE, BASED ON LOSS LOCATION. INFORMATION IN JTF-FA FILES, INCLUDING U.S. AND SRV DOCUMENTATION, AND THE RESULTS OF FIELD INVESTIGATION AND EXCAVATION, INDICATES THAT CASE DATA WAS THE ONLY CASE TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN QUANG YEN VILLAGE. THE DISAPPEARANCE OF THE BURIAL SITE NOTED IN THIS DOCUMENT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE RESULTS OF FIELD INVESTIGATION.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "3); QUANG CHAU (QUANG XUONG); GRAVE EXTANT." ((THIS ENTRY PROBABLY CORRELATES WITH RESOLVED CASE 0667, BASED ON LOCATION AND PRESENCE OF A GRAVE. A 15-KM GRID SEARCH CENTERED ON THIS VILLAGE (WG 9285) SHOWS 19 AIRCRAFT LOSSES. OF THESE 19, 12 WERE EITHER OPERATIONAL LOSSES OR RETURNEES. OF THE REMAINING SEVEN, ONLY TWO ARE CLOSE TO QUANG CHAU VILLAGE, ACCORDING TO SEALOSS. BOTH OF THESE, CASES 0092 AND 0667, WERE RESOLVED BY UNILATERAL REPATRIATION OF REMAINS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF JOINT FIELD INVESTIGATIONS, SO THE ACTUAL BURIAL LOCATIONS WERE NEVER CONFIRMED. REF C SHOWS THAT THE 0092 AIRCRAFT CRASHED OFF THE COAST OF QUANG NHAM VILLAGE. THIS LOCATION IS ABOUT 20 KM SOUTH OF QUANG CHAU VILLAGE. REF B PLACES THE CRASH SITE OF THE ENTRY CORRELATED WITH 0667 BETWEEN QUANG VINH AND QUANG HUNG VILLAGES, ABOUT 4 KM SOUTH OF QUANG CHAU VILLAGE. //

SUBJ/ANALYSIS OF VIETNAMESE DOCUMENTATION TITLED: "SITUATION OF RMKS/

ACCORDING TO INFORMATION IN THE CASE 0667 FILE, THE INDIVIDUAL LOST IN THIS INCIDENT EJECTED SAFELY FROM HIS AIRCRAFT, AND DISAPPEARED INTO A TREE LINE AT THE EDGE OF QUANG CHAU VILLAGE. HE WAS NEVER HEARD FROM AGAIN. THE NOTATION IN A DOCUMENT THAT A GRAVE SITE STILL EXISTS IS ALMOST ALWAYS AN INDICATION THAT THE ENTRY CORRELATES WITH A RESOLVED CASE. LTJG GRAHAM WAS EITHER KILLED BY LOCAL FORCES DURING OR AFTER CAPTURE, OR DIED AS A RESULT OF INJURIES SUFFERED PRIOR TO OR UPON LANDING. HE WAS PROBABLY BURIED IN QUANG CHAU VILLAGE.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "4); QUANG CHINH (QUANG XUONG); GRAVE LOST." ((THIS ENTRY POSSIBLY CORRELATES WITH RESOLVED CASE 0457, BASED ON LOCATION OF LOSS. THIS CASE WAS RESOLVED BY UNILATERAL REPATRIATION OF REMAINS PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF FIELD INVESTIGATIONS, SO THE DATA IN U.S. FILES OF THIS CASE HAS NOT BEEN CONFIRMED IN THE FIELD. NEVERTHE-

LESS, DURING THE INVESTIGATION OF ANOTHER CASE IN THE AREA, A JOINT TEAM INTERVIEWED A WITNESS IN QUANG CHINH VILLAGE WHO PROVIDED INFORMATION WHICH CORRELATES WITH CASE 0457, TO INCLUDE BURIAL AND SUBSEQUENT RECOVERY OF REMAINS IN THE VILLAGE (REF E). THERE ARE NO OTHER CASES IN QUANG CHINH VILLAGE. NOTE: SUBJECT DOCUMENT INDICATES THAT THE GRAVE IN QUANG CHINH WAS LOST. NEVERTHELESS, THE SRV REPATRIATED THE REMAINS OF CASE 0457 IN 1983. THIS INFORMATION SUGGESTS THAT THE SUCCESSFUL RECOVERY OF REMAINS TOOK PLACE AFTER SUBJECT DOCUMENT WAS PREPARED. THE WITNESS FROM QUANG CHINH VILLAGE DID NOT INDICATE WHEN HE GUIDED THE OFFICIAL RECOVERY PARTY TO THE BURIAL SITE.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "5); QUANG HAI (QUANG XUONG); 1 GUY; GRAVE EXTANT." ((THIS INFORMATION POSSIBLY CORRELATES WITH RESOLVED CASE 0255. ONE OF THE TWO CREWMEN IN THIS CASE IS A RETURNEE. THE OTHER WAS RESOLVED BY UNILATERAL REPATRIATION OF REMAINS IN DEC 88, BEFORE A JOINT INVESTIGATION OF THE CASE TOOK PLACE. CONSEQUENTLY, THE ACTUAL LOSS LOCATION HAS NEVER BEEN DETERMINED. THE RECORD LOSS LOCATION IS IN QUANG NHAM VILLAGE, 7 KM SOUTH OF QUANG HAI VILLAGE. HOWEVER, AN INTERVIEW REPORT IN THE CASE 0255 FILE PROVIDES INFORMATION WHICH CORRELATES VERY CLOSELY WITH THE TESTIMONY OF THE RETURNEE IN THIS INCIDENT. THE INTERVIEWEE STATED THAT THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE IN QUANG HAI VILLAGE. IN ADDITION, REF C CONTAINS AN ENTRY WHICH CORRELATES WITH CASE 0255 WHICH PLACES THE CRASH SITE OFF THE COAST OF QUANG HAI VILLAGE. THERE WERE NO OTHER INCIDENTS IN THIS AREA ON 18 FEB 66. INFORMATION ACCOMPANYING THE REPATRIATED REMAINS INDICATES THAT THEY WERE RECOVERED IN TINH GIA DISTRICT. NO OTHER DETAILS ARE PROVIDED. ALTHOUGH THIS INFORMATION DOES NOT SUPPORT THE CORRELATION PROPOSED ABOVE, IT IS NOT SUFFICIENT BY ITSELF TO OVERRULE IT.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "6); QUANG DINH (QUANG XUONG); 2 GUYS; GRAVES EXTANT." ((THIS LINE ENTRY POSSIBLY CORRELATES WITH RESOLVED CASE 1789, BASED ON PROVINCE, DISTRICT AND VILLAGE OF LOSS. CASE 1789 WAS THE ONLY CASE TO INVOLVE THE LOSS OF TWO U. S. SERVICE MEMBERS WITHIN 15 KILOMETERS OF QUANG DINH VILLAGE. IN ADDITION, A WARTIME NEWS REPORT CORRELATED WITH THIS CASE PLACES THE INCIDENT LOCATION IN QUANG DINH VILLAGE. THE REMAINS OF BOTH SERVICEMEN WERE REPATRIATED IN APR 88, BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF JOINT FIELD INVESTIGATION. CONSEQUENTLY, THE LOSS LOCATION OF THIS INCIDENT HAS NEVER BEEN CONFIRMED. INFORMATION ACCOMPANYING THE REPATRIATED REMAINS INDICATES THAT THEY WERE RECOVERED IN HOANG HOA DISTRICT, THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF WHICH LIES 4 KM NORTH OF QUANG DINH VILLAGE. ALTHOUGH THIS INFORMATION DOES NOT SUPPORT THE CORRELATION ESTABLISHED ABOVE, IT IS INSUFFICIENT TO OVERRULE IT.))

- ((LINE ENTRY)) "7); HAI LINH (TINH GIA); 1 GUY; GRAVE LOST." ((THERE IS INSUFFICIENT INFORMATION IN JTF-FA FILES TO PERMIT CORRELATION OF THIS ENTRY. A 15-KM GRID SEARCH CENTERED ON HAI LINH VILLAGE (WG 8455) SHOWS 13 AIRCRAFT LOSSES, NONE OF THEM IN HAI LINH VILLAGE ITSELF. OF THESE 13 INCIDENTS, 7 INVOLVE OPERATIONAL LOSSES OR RETURNEES. OF THE REMAINING SIX, TWO ARE OVERWATER LOSSES NEAR HON ME ISLAND, 15 KM SE OF HAI LINH VILLAGE. TWO OTHERS, BOTH RESOLVED CASES, CORRELATE MORE CLOSELY WITH OTHER ENTRIES IN THIS

DOCUMENT. OF THE TWO REMAINING INCIDENTS, FIELD INVESTIGATION SHOWS THAT UNRESOLVED CASE 0578 PROBABLY TOOK PLACE IN HAI CHAU VILLAGE, 10 KM DUE NORTH OF HAI LINH VILLAGE (REF E). THE LAST INCIDENT IS RESOLVED CASE 0255, RESOLVED BY UNILATERAL REPATRIATION OF REMAINS IN 1983. INFORMATION IN THE CASE FILE AND IN SRV DOCUMENTS, INDICATES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL KILLED IN THIS INCIDENT DIED IN QUANG HAI VILLAGE, QUANG XUONG DISTRICT, 20 KM DUE NORTH OF HAI LINH VILLAGE. THE NOTATION THAT THE GRAVE HAS BEEN LOST IS A STRONG INDICATION THAT NO REMAINS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS INCIDENT HAVE BEEN REPATRIATED. RECOMMEND INVESTIGATION OF THIS INFORMATION IN HAI LINH VILLAGE. NO JOINT TEAM HAS YET VISITED HAI LINH VILLAGE, AS NO INCIDENT IN JTF-FA FILES IS KNOWN TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE THERE.))
